This application has been preferred by the petitioner for condonation the delay of 116 days in filing the criminal revision.

In view of the fact that sufficient reasons have been shown with respect to delay of 116 days which had occurred in filing this criminal revision, the same is condoned and this I.A. is allowed and disposed of.

Criminal Revision No. 903 of 2017

It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that neither the trial court nor the appellate court has correctly appreciated the material available on record while convicting the petitioner for the offence punishable u/s 307/448 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-B)a of the Arms Act and the maximum sentence awarded to him is to undergo R.I. six years. It has also been submitted that the petitioner was acquitted for the offence u/s 26 of the Arms Act by the learned appellate court and that the petitioner is in custody since 13.11.2013.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has remained in custody for more than half of the sentence awarded to him, during pendency of this application, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court [Assistant Sessions Judge-I, West Singhbhum at Chaibasa] in connection with Sessions Trial Case No. 171 of 2007(S).
