By the Court:- Heard the parties.

2. Though, notice has validly been served upon the opposite party nos.2 to 4, but no one turns up on behalf of the opposite party no.2 to 4 in spite of repeated calls.

3. This Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed invoking the jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India

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with the prayer for a direction to the Family Court, Hazaribagh to dispose of the Cr. Misc. Application No.01 of 2025 which was filed under Section 379 of BNSS, 2023.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the said case was filed on 24.03.2025, but the Family Court, Hazaribagh is sitting over the matter and is not disposing of the same and the next date fixed is 17.07.2026 for preliminary enquiry.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the State has no serious objection.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, this C.M.P. is disposed of with the direction to the Family Court, Hazaribagh that keeping in view the fact that Criminal Miscellaneous Application is pending for more than a year; it is desirable that the same must be disposed of within 03 months from the date of receipt of this order by the Family Court, Hazaribagh.

7. In the result, this C.M.P., is allowed.

8. Accordingly, this C.M.P. is disposed of with the aforesaid observation.
