02/04.05.2026 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Bhawnathpur P.S. Case No.24 of 2026, for the alleged offences registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 351(2), 351(3), 352 and 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Garhwa.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that children were playing cricket and they started quarrelling and thereafter the elders have also involved. He further submits that

there are case and counter case between the parties and both the sides have received the injury. He then submits that the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.12 of the petition.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that the allegations of assault are there.

5. Considering that the children were playing cricket and they started quarrelling and thereafter elders have also involved and there are case and counter case between the parties and both the sides have received the injury and the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.12 of the petition, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of their surrender/arrest, the petitioners, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Garhwa in connection with Bhawnathpur P.S. Case No.24 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
