This criminal miscellaneous petition has been filed at the instance of the petitioner for restoration of B.A. No. 9596 of 2025 to its original file.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that B.A. No. 9596 of 2025 was dismissed for non-compliance of the peremptory order of filing supplementary affidavit. It is next submitted that due to inadvertence, the said supplementary affidavit could not be filed within the stipulated time hence, the same resulted in dismissal of B.A. No. 9596 of 2025. It is further submitted that non-compliance of peremptory order was neither deliberate nor intentional.
