Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for two weeks' time to remove the surviving defects, as mentioned in the office note dated 18.11.2022.

Learned counsel for the respondents/ State Mr. Deepankar, AC to Mr. Rajiv Ranjan, learned Advocate General has submitted, that in terms of order dated 01.11.2022, this Court has granted two weeks' time to the petitioner for removing the surviving defects, but the same have not been removed as yet.

The Surviving defects are as follows :-

Defect No. 1 – Copy may be served to respondent no. 3 to 5.

Defect No. 5 – F/c or T/c of Page No. 29 to 43, 40 to 52, 55 to 68 may be given.

Defect No. 6 – T/c of Page no. 53, 54 may be given.

Considering the same, two weeks' time is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to remove the surviving defects, failing which, the writ petition shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

Put up this case on 13.12.2022 under the appropriate heading, if writ petition survives.
