Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Pindrajora P.S. Case No. 201 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 351(2), 3(5) of the B.N.S., 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner in a well-planned conspiracy,
in furtherance of common intention with the co-accused persons were
instrumental in selling the silicon manganese which was transported by
the co-accused persons. It is next submitted that the petitioner is not
named in the F.I.R. and he is the son of the co-accused Satyendra Yadav
and he was only driving the truck. It is further submitted that the
petitioner has been implicated in this case only on the basis of his
confessional statement and leading to recovery of part of stolen silicon
manganese, which was concealed under bushes. It is next submitted that
the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is then submitted that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 03 of the
supplementary affidavit dated 08.05.2026. It is submitted that charge-
sheet has been submitted against the petitioner. It also submitted that the
petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and
will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case. It is
lastly submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 19.12.2025

as mentioned in para-01 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bokaro in connection with Pindrajora P.S. Case No. 201 of 2025 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
