This application has been preferred by the petitioner for condoning a delay of 206 days in filing the revision application.

The reason which has been assigned in the instant application is that the petitioner was not aware about the disposal of the criminal appeal and therefore, no steps could be taken for filing the revision application within time.

Having considered the reasons assigned in the instant application, the same is allowed and the delay of 206 days in filing the revision application is hereby condoned.

Let this case be listed under the heading **“For Orders”** immediately after service of notice upon the opposite party no. 2.

Till the next date of listing, no coercive step shall be taken as against the petitioner in connection with Complaint Case No. 541 of 2017, pending before the concerned Court.
