2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Chaupraran P.S. Case No. 86 of 2025, registered under sections 274, 275,
292, 317(5), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and section 47(a) of Excise Act, pending in
the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Hazaribagh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner
happens to be owner of Bolero vehicle and allegations are made that 20
cartons of illegal liquor was recovered from the said vehicle. He further
submits that said vehicle was handed over to the driver for taking patients
however driver has loaded the said liquor. On these grounds, he submits
that the petitioner may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and
submits that Bolero vehicle is not commercial vehicle and it has come that
by changing number plate of the said vehicle liquor was being carried and
in view of that anticipatory bail of the petitioner may kindly be rejected.

5. Considering that Bolero vehicle is not commercial vehicle and
it has been alleged that by changing number plate of the said vehicle
liquor was being carried and petitioner is owner of the said vehicle, I am

not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, his prayer for anticipatory bail is hereby rejected.
