04/28.11.2025 It is submitted by the learned counsel for the State that as Smt. Anjali Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Godda has already appeared and as such, he is not pressing I.A. No. 15774 of 2025.

2. Under the circumstances, I.A. No. 15774 of 2025 is dismissed as not pressed for.

I.A. No. 13124 of 2025

3. After some arguments, Mr. Ranjit Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the I.A. No. 13124 of 2025.

4. Learned counsel for the State raised no objection.

5. In view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the appellant, the learned counsel for the appellant is permitted to withdraw I.A. No. 13124 of 2025 at this stage.

6. Accordingly, I.A. No. 13124 of 2025 is dismissed as withdrawn.

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7. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

8. Pursuant to the order dated 13.11.2025 passed by this Court, Smt. Anjali Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Sri Mukesh Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Godda are present in Court today.

9. This Court after interacting with Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Superintendent of Police, Godda, this Court is of the view that District Administration has to go through comprehensive schemes for payment of monetary compensation to the victim girls under the provisions of Victim Compensation Scheme and also for rehabilitation of the victims including Education and work, if so required. Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Superintendent of Police, Godda have assured that they will examine the matter and they will prepare scheme for entire district of Godda. This Court also suggests that Support Officer should also involve in such cases after lodging of the FIR under the provisions of POCSO Act.

10. Accordingly, put up this case on 22.12.2025.

11. Under the circumstances, personal appearance of Smt. Anjali Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Sri Mukesh Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Godda are dispensed with for the present.

12. However, Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Superintendent of Police, Godda shall appear through Video Conferencing on 22.12.2025. In the meantime, they may also take necessary steps.
