**06/22.12.2025** Pursuant to order dated 28.11.2025, Mrs. Anjali Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Mr. Mukesh Kumar, Superintendent of Police, Godda are present through Video conferencing.

Video and Audio quality are proper and there is no complaint.

**2.** The Deputy Commissioner has informed that although the learned Trial Court has awarded compensation of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lacs) each to the two victims as well as to the mother of the victim girls, however, after considering the facts and circumstances of this case, they have enhanced the compensation from Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakh) each to Rs. 7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven lakh) each, to both the victim girls and thus the victim girls will be getting Rs.14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen lakh) in total. It is further informed that even the compensation of the mother of the victim girls has been enhanced from Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs) to Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees Four lakh) and thus,

the victims and their mother will now get Rs.18,00,000/- (Rupees Eighteen lacs) as compensation. It has further been submitted that they have sensitized all the doctors and the staff of the hospital that they shall conduct the medical examination of the victim girls promptly. It has been stated that they have earmarked Mahila Thana so that the victims may feel comfortable. It has also been informed that they have taken steps for rehabilitation of the victims and they have also taken steps for skill development of the victims in the future.

**3.** A number of other measures have also been suggested by the Deputy Commissioner, Godda in presence of Superintendent of Police, Godda. It is also informed that they are in coordination with D.L.S.A., Godda also and they will also seek assistance about compensation from the learned Principal District & Sessions Judge, Godda and D.L.S.A., Godda.

**4.** The measures taken by Mrs. Anjali Yadav, Deputy Commissioner, Godda is appreciated by this Court.

**5.** The action taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Godda is laudable, however, it will be desirable that all the measures taken by the District Administration in this case may be brought on record by filing an affidavit, which will include the steps taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Godda and

Superintendent of Police, Godda so that it may be followed in other cases also.

**6.** Under the circumstances, put up this case on 13.01.2026 and in the meantime, Mr. Pankaj Kumar, learned Public Prosecutor will file a detailed counter affidavit along with the details of the steps taken by the Deputy Commissioner, Godda and Superintendent of Police, Godda.
