Heard the parties.

The petitioners have been made accused in connection with Pachamba P.S. Case No.24 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under Section 303 (2), 317 (2), 317 (4), 317 (5) of the B.N.S., 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners is that the petitioners have committed theft of motorcycles from various districts. It is submitted that the allegation against the petitioners is false. It is further submitted that though charge-sheet has already been submitted in this case but no witness has been examined as yet. It is then submitted that the petitioners undertake that they will co-operate with the trial of the case and that they will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners have been in custody since 10.03.2026 as has been mentioned in para-12 of the

instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioners be released on bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Giridih in connection with Pachamba P.S. Case No.24 of 2026 **with the condition that they will co-operate with the trial of the case, furnish their mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that they will not change their mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
