Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Patratu P.S. Case No. 33 of 2026, instituted under Section 305 (e)/
317 (2), 317(4), 329(3), 61(2) (b), 112(2) of BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner was
involved in commission of theft of 850 metres of copper wire,
which were in pieces, from the plant of the informant. It is next
submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false and the
petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2026, as mentioned at para 11
of the bail application. Learned counsel for the petitioner has files
supplementary affidavit and the same is taken on record. It is
next submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the
petitioner is ready and willing to co-operate with the trial of the
case and undertakes not to annoy or disturb the informant or the
other witnesses of the case in any manner during trial of the case
and he will not go to or near the place of occurrence i.e. the land
of the informant where the alleged occurrence took place, hence,
the petitioner may be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for regular bail.

Considering submissions of learned counsels and the facts
as stated above, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail.
Hence, the court below is directed to release the petitioner on bail

on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned JMFC at Ramgarh in connection with Patratu P.S. Case No. 33 of 2026 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish mobile phone number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change the mobile phone number during the trial of the case and he undertakes not to annoy or disturb the informant or the other witnesses of the case in any manner during trial of the case and he will not go to or near the place of occurrence, during the pendency of the case.
