The present interlocutory application has been filed on behalf of the applicant for substitution of the sole petitioner, namely, Chhabibala Dasi, who died on 19.01.2022, during pendency of the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the sole petitioner, namely, Chhabibala Dasi died on 19.01.2022, during pendency of the present writ petition, leaving behind the applicant, who is her son, as her heir and legal representative, whose description has been given in paragraph 1(i) of the present interlocutory application. The death certificate of the deceased petitioner has been annexed as Annexure-IA-1 to the present interlocutory application. It is further submitted that the husband of the deceased petitioner, namely, Uma Shankar Dey had predeceased her. Hence, the said heir/legal representative may be substituted in place of the deceased petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State-respondents raises no objection to the present interlocutory application.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and for the reasons stated in the present interlocutory application, let the deceased petitioner, namely, Chhabibala Dasi be substituted by her heir/legal representative, whose

description has been given in paragraph 1(i) of the present interlocutory application.

Learned counsel for the applicant is directed to make necessary amendment in the cause title of the said writ petition in course of the day.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the Vakalatnama on behalf of the newly substituted petitioner has already been filed along with the present interlocutory application.

The present interlocutory application stands disposed of.
