Mr. Abhay Prakash, learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment passed by the Apex Court in the case of *Union Public Service Commission etc.& Ors., vs. Angesh Kumar & Ors.* etc., reported in *2018(4) SCC 530*.
