This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

It has been submitted Mr. Jitendra S. Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already extended an amount of Rs. 11,33,800/- to the opposite party No. 2. It has further been submitted that after the dismissal of the appeal an amount of Rs. 2,33,800/- has been deposited before the learned trial court and during evidence in the trial, the opposite party has admitted of receiving an amount of Rs. 6 Lakhs.

Issue notice to the opposite party No. 2 as to why this application shall not be admitted and/or disposed of at the admission stage itself for which requisite etc. under speed post as well as by ordinary process must be filed by 14.05.2026.
