This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioner for exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court, Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the entire compensation amount has been extended by the petitioner to the tune of Rs.4,40,000/- based on a settlement entered into between the petitioner and the O.P. No.2.

Learned counsel for the O.P. No. 2 has accepted the factum of compromise and the receipt of the amount of Rs.4,40,000/-.

In view of the aforesaid, the same being a sufficient cause, the petitioner is exempted to surrender in connection with C. Case No. 404 of 2021
