2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Bengabad PS Case No.177 of 2025, for offence registered under section 303(2), 317(2) read with section 3(5) of BNS, 2023, pending in court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Giridih.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement and the allegations are made of theft of Scorpio car. She further submits that the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.13 of the petition.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement.

5. Considering that the name of the petitioner has come on confessional statement and the petitioner is having no criminal antecedent as aforesaid, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to

the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before learned court within two weeks from today, and in event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Giridih, in connection with Bengabad PS Case No.177 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
