As per the office note, notice which was issued to opposite party No.1 has been returned unserved.

2. This Civil Revision application is filed against the order dated 21st April, 2018, whereby in Title Suit No.241 of 2015, the learned Sub Judge-VII, Ranchi, has dismissed the application under Order VII Rule 11 CPC, filed by the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the plaintiff is appearing before the Trial Court and is taking steps but is not accepting the notice which has been sent by this Court in this case. He prays that he may be allowed to serve notice to them through the learned counsel who is appearing on behalf of the plaintiff before the Trial Court in Title Suit No.241 of 2015.

4. Considering the submission that the plaintiff is appearing before the Trial Court and is avoiding service of notice in this case, the petitioner is allowed to serve notice through the Lawyer of the plaintiff who is representing them in Title Suit No.241 of 2015. Requisites etc., should be filed by ordinary process within a week.

5. The office after processing the same, will handover the

same to the learned counsel who will ensure service to the Lawyer of the plaintiff in Title Suit No.241 of 2015 and file an affidavit to that effect.

6. A copy of this order should also be communicated to the concerned counsel representing the plaintiff in Title Suit No.241 of 2015.
