**02/06.05.2026** Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner as well as  
learned counsel appearing for the State.

**2.** The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with  
M.G.M. (Mango Muffasil) P.S. Case No.180 of 2025, for the alleged  
offences registered under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 118, 352,  
351(2), 190, 191(2), 192(3), 109 and 303(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita,  
2023 pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class,  
Jamshedpur.

**3.** Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the  
allegations of assault are there, however, that allegation is not there  
against the petitioner and only it has been alleged that the petitioner has  
asked to take vehicle in a parking place. He further submits that the  
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.17  
of the petition.

**4.** Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer and submits that allegation of assault are there.

**5.** On query made by the Court, learned counsel appearing for the State fairly submits that allegation of assault is not there so far petitioner is concerned.

**5.** Looking into the contents of the FIR it transpires that the allegation of assault is not there against the petitioner and only the petitioner has requested to take the vehicle on the parking place and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph No.17 of the petition, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

**6.** Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Jamshedpur in connection with M.G.M. (Mango Muffasil) P.S. Case No.180 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
