2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Balidih PS Case No.252 of 2024, for offence registered under section 190, 191, 109(1), 115, 118(1), 118(2), 126 and 127 of BNS, 2023 and section 27 of the Arms Act, pending in court of learned SDJM, Bokaro.

3. Learned counsel for petitioners submits that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case and they have not committed the offence as alleged in the FIR and there is no eye witness to the said occurrence and lastly, he contended that there is specific allegation against the co-accused Samiruddin Ansari of firing and so far these petitioners are concerned, there is no such allegation against them and the petitioners are having no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.13 of the petition. He also submits that the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory

bail by the coordinate Bench by this Court in ABA No.7238 of 2024.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that the petitioners are named in the FIR and they are accomplice to co-accused Samiruddin Ansari.

5. Considering that two of the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail as aforesaid and the petitioners are having no criminal as aforesaid and the allegations of firing is upon one Samiruddin Ansari, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners, above named, are hereby directed to surrender before learned court within two weeks from today, and in event of their surrender/arrest, both the petitioners, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned SDJM, Bokaro, in connection with Balidih PS Case No.252 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
