learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection
with Pakur Town (Malpahari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 280 of 2025, registered
for the offence under Sections 126(2), 117(2), 118(1), 109, 352,
351(2) and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the court
of learned S.D.J.M., Pakur.

3. Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that there are general and omnibus allegations against these
petitioners of making assault and the altercation took place due to land
dispute and both the sides are agnates. He further submits that three
of the co-accused persons have been granted anticipatory bail in A.B.A.
No.2156 of 2026. On this ground, he submits that anticipatory bail may
kindly be provided to the petitioners.

4. Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State has opposed the
prayer and submits that allegation of making assault is there and in
view of that the prayer for anticipatory bail may kindly be rejected.

5. Considering that the co-accused persons in identical
situation have been granted anticipatory bail in the aforesaid A.B.A., I
am inclined to extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the
petitioners named above.

6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender, they shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Pakur, in connection with Pakur Town (Malpahari O.P.) P.S. Case No. 280 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
