Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Chaibasa (Muffasil) P.S. Case No.99 of 2007 corresponding to Spt. G.R. Case No. 386 of 2007 registered for the offences punishable under sections 379, 420, 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner has committed theft of the truck purchased by the informant being financed by the employer of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the co-accused person who has been arrayed as an accused has been acquitted in G.R. Case No. 386 of 2007. It is next submitted that the offences involved in this case are triable by the Magistrate. It is then submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as has been mentioned in para -17 of the bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 07.02.2026, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 01 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any

manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the above-named petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Singhbhum at Chaibasa, in connection with Chaibasa (Muffasil) P.S. Case No.99 of 2007 corresponding to Spt. G.R. Case No. 386 of 2007 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
