This application has been preferred by the petitioner for condoning a delay of 50 days in filing the revision application.

Having been satisfied with the reasons assigned in the instant application, the same is allowed and the delay of 50 days in filing the revision application is hereby condoned.

I.A. No. 5082 of 2026 stands disposed of.

I.A. No. 5503 of 2026

This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of bail to him during the pendency of this revision application.

The petitioner has been convicted for the offences u/s 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and has been sentenced to undergo S.I. for 01 year and has been directed to pay compensation amount of Rs. 3,77600/- to the complainant.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that neither the learned trial court nor the learned appellate court had made appropriate consideration with respect to the factual aspects of the case. It has been submitted that the matter has been

compromised between the parties and the entire dispute has been settled at Rs. 1,50,000/- out of which an amount of Rs. 75,520/- has already been extended to the opposite party no. 2. Learned counsel adds that the petitioner is in custody since 31.03.2026.

Regard being had to the above, during the pendency of this revision application, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Hazaribag in Complaint Case No. 979 of 2023.

I.A. No. 5503 of 2026 stands disposed of.
