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09/ 07.05.2026 Heard, learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the respondent-NHAI.

2. It is grievance of the petitioners that the land and building of the petitioners has been acquired for construction of National Highway under the National Highways Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they have already preferred an application before the District Land Acquisition Officer for taking appropriate steps under the Act, but neither any order has been passed and nor any action has been taken pursuant to their representation. He submits that suffice it would be if a direction is given to the respondents to dispose of their representation and thereafter take

appropriate steps in terms of the National Highways Act.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that if the application of the petitioner is still pending, an appropriate order will be passed and a decision will be taken.

5. In view of the submissions of the learned counsel of both the parties, I direct the petitioners to approach the District Land Acquisition Officer, Sahebganj for ventilating their grievance, who in turn will consider the grievance of the petitioners and pass appropriate order in terms of National Highways Act within eight weeks from today.

6. Accordingly, this writ petition stands disposed of.
