2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Adityapur PS Case No.275 of 2025, for offence registered under section 126(2), 127(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 324(4), 125(a), 125(b), 352, 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023, pending in court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate at Seraikella.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the altercation took place due to parking of scooter between the other co-accused persons who are named in the FIR. He next submits that only allegations are there against the petitioner of reaching on the spot later on and thereafter it has been alleged that all have assaulted and that is general and omnibus. He next submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as disclosed in paragraph no.13 of the petition.

4. Learned State counsel opposes prayer and submits that

allegation of assault is there.

5. On perusal of the FIR it transpires that altercation took place between the other co-accused persons whose names have been disclosed in the content of the FIR and that was due to parking of the scooter and allegation is made that the petitioner and others have reached there later on and there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as aforesaid, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before learned court within two weeks from today, and in event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate at Seraikella, in connection with Adityapur PS Case No.275 of 2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
