Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with S.T. No. 410 of 2025 arising out of Bhawnathpur P.S. Case No.137 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under sections 309(6)/311 of the B.N.S., 2023.

The learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that this is the second journey of the petitioner with the prayer for regular bail and the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner looted the motorcycle and mobile phone. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and in the meanwhile one of the witnesses has been examined but he could not identify the petitioner as the petitioner fled away from the place of occurrence before arrival of P.W.2 who is the brother-in-law of the victim at the place of occurrence. It is next submitted that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is scheduled to take place on 25.04.2026 hence, the petitioner does not press the prayer for regular bail and prays that the petitioner be admitted to provisional bail to enable him to attend the marriage of his sister.

Considering the fact, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail provisionally till 28.04.2026 on the petitioner depositing cash security of Rs.50,000/- and on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-

with two solvent sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.S.J.-I, Nagar Untari, Garhwa, in connection with S.T. No. 410 of 2025 arising out of Bhawnathpur P.S. Case No.137 of 2025.

The petitioner is directed to file a supplementary affidavit on or by 04.05.2026 showing proof of his surrender before the court below on 28.04.2026.
