2. The applicant, who is in custody since 20.02.2025 has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No. 80 of 2025 arising out of S.T. Case No. 07 of 2026, registered for the offence under Section 324(5), 326(f), 111(3), 111(4), 308(4), 308(5), 61(2) of the BN.S.,2023 and 27 of the Arms Act, pending in the court of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Latehar.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the applicant(s) that complete set of F.I.R. along with its enclosures have been annexed with this bail application and there is no suppression on his/her part.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the applicant earlier the prayer for bail of the applicant has been rejected by this Court in B.A. No.10053 of 2025 vide order dated 16.02.2026.

5. It has been further submitted that fresh ground for renewing the prayer for grant of regular bail is that charge has been framed on 27.01.2026 in this case and several co-accused persons have been granted regular bail i.e., Mukesh Kumar has been granted bail on 14.01.2026 in B.A. No. 11283 of 2025; Bablu Kumar has been granted bail on 11.02.2026 in B.A. No. 12024 of 2025; Rakesh Kumar has been granted bail on 09.03.2026 in B.A. No. 1120 of 2026 and Baleshwar Kumar @ Baleshwar @ Satya has been granted bail on 12.03.2026 in B.A. No. 11481 of 2025 by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

6. Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the applicant.

7. Considering the period of custody undergone by the applicant and also the fact similarly situated co-accused have been granted bail, I am

inclined to enlarge the applicant on bail.

8. Accordingly, the applicant, named above, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-III, Latehar in connection with Balumath P.S. Case No. 80 of 2025 arising out of S.T. Case No. 07 of 2026 , subject to condition that the applicant(s) will submit self-attested photocopy/photocopies of his/her/their Aadhaar Card(s) and also submit his/her/their mobile number(s) before the learned trial court which he/she/they will always keep active and will not change it during pendency of this case without prior permission of the court..
