- 2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Borio P.S. Case No. 07 of 2026, registered for the offence under Sections 316(2), 318(4), 303(2), 334(2), 115(2), 117(2), 126(2) and 3(5) of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending in the court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sahibganj.
- 3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the informant is the sister of petitioner no.2. He submits that the allegations are there that house was handed over to informant, however, the same was taken back after five years. He further submits that in the FIR, vital part has been concealed to the effect that the informant has entered into agreement with petitioner no.1 and paid Rupees Four Lakhs to him for construction of her house. He also submits that entire family members have been made accused.
- 4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer and submits that it appears that the house previously provided was taken back by the petitioner no.1.
- 5. Considering that the informant is own sister of petitioner no.2 and for the alleged allegation as noted in the argument of learned

counsel for the petitioners and entire family members have been made accused, in the attending facts and circumstance, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the above-named petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned Court within two weeks from today and in the event of their arrest or surrender, they shall be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sahibganj, in connection with Borio P.S. Case No. 07 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
