I.A. No.5231 of 2025

I.A No.5231 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 5 of the Limitation Act for condoning the delay of 48 days.

2. It has been submitted that daughter of the petitioner was seriously ill and petitioner is a farmer and is not aware of the technicality and due to medical emergency of his daughter, he could not file Criminal Revision Application within time and hence the delay of 48 days may be condoned.

3. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP for the State and in view of the averments made in paragraph 4 to 7 of the Interlocutory Application, the delay of 48 days in filing the instant Criminal Revision Application is condoned.

5. Thus, I.A. No.5231 of 2025 is allowed and stands disposed of.

I.A. No.5270 of 2025

6. I.A No.5270 of 2025 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner under Rule 159 of the High Court of Jharkhand Rules, 2001 seeking exemption from surrendering before the learned Court below.

7. It is submitted that the petitioner is ready to settle the dispute with the O.P. No.2 and for the present also he will deposit Demand Draft of Rs.2,00,000/- out of cheque amount of Rs.4,00,000/- in the office of the learned Registrar General and hence the petitioner may be exempted from surrendering before the learned Court below.

8. Learned APP submitted to pass necessary order.

9. Issue notice to the O.P. No.2 in I.A. No.5270 of 2025 and also in the matter of admission as to why this Criminal Revision Application be not admitted and/or disposed of at the time of admission stage itself, by registered post with A/D as well as ordinary process and for which, requisites etc. must be filed within one week after Summer Vacation, failing which this Criminal Revision Application shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

10. Put up this case on 16.07.2025, if requisites are filed.

11. If petitioner deposits Demand Draft of Rs.2,00,000/- in the name of the O.P. No.2 before the office of the learned Registrar General then no coercive step shall be taken against the petitioner.

12. Let a copy of this order be sent to the learned Registrar General and to the learned Court below.
