Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Rail  
Dhanbad P.S. Case No. 10 of 2024 corresponding to NDPS Case No.03 of  
2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 20(b) (ii)(c), 22,  
29 of the NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation  
against the petitioner is that the co-accused person Binod Kumar Singh  
and Sunil Kumar Pandit nabbed by the police while Rajendra Shah fled  
away and from the place of occurrence and 27.9 Kg of contraband was  
recovered. It is next submitted that the only allegation against the  
petitioner is that the co-accused persons in their statement before police  
disclosed that at the instance of the petitioner, they were having the  
contraband and the petitioner has given them cash of Rs.50,000/- for the  
procurement of Ganja. It is submitted that the allegation against the  
petitioner is false. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal  
antecedent as has been mentioned in para-14 of this bail application. It is  
next submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with  
the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or  
witnesses of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has been in  
custody since 24.02.2026 as mentioned in para-15 of the instant bail  
application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Spl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Dhanbad in connection with Rail Dhanbad P.S. Case No. 10 of 2024 corresponding to NDPS Case No.03 of 2024 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case.
