Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Pachambha P.S. Case No.14 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under sections 303(2), 317(2), 317(4), 317(5), 336(2) & 238(C) of the B.N.S., 2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner was involved in theft of a motorcycle. It is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is then submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 21.02.2026 as is evident from rejection order of regular bail application of the petitioner by the court below vide order dated 24.03.2026 in B.P. No. 151 of 2026. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as has been mentioned in para-11 of the bail application. It is then submitted that the co-accused person has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 29.04.2026 in B.A. No. 3579 of 2026. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and also undertakes not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case and not to indulge in any offence, while on bail, in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Giridih in connection with Pachamba P.S. Case No. 14 of 2026 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case and he will not indulge in any offence, while on bail, in any manner during the trial of the case.
