Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Ranchi Sadar P.S. Case No. 49 of 2026 instituted for the offences punishable under Section 109(1) of BNS, 2023 and under Section 27 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner filed the supplementary affidavit keep the same on record.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner has fired in the air to create panic and fear associated with gang involved in extortion of money by creating terror and panic. It is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false and the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the supplementary affidavit. The petitioner is in custody since 18.02.2026 as mentioned in para 11 of the bail application. It is next submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready and willing to co-operate with the trial of the case and undertakes not to annoy or disturb the informant or the other witnesses of the case in any manner during trial of the case, hence, the petitioner may be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for regular bail.

Considering submissions of learned counsels and the facts as stated above and no injury has been sustained by any of any of the

person, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Hence, the court below is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate-IV, Ranchi in connection with Ranchi Sadar P.S. Case No. 49 of 2026 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish mobile phone number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change the mobile phone number during the trial of the case and he undertakes not to annoy or disturb the informant or the other witnesses of the case in any manner during the pendency of the case.
