Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved this Court for grant of bail in connection with Giridih (T) P.S. Case No.420 of 2013 registered for the offences punishable under sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the co-accused -Fuldev Singh executed a power of attorney by impersonating as Mahesh Singh in favour of the informant in furtherance of common intention with the petitioner. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the main allegation is against Ful Dev Singh. It is next submitted that the petitioner is not a signatory to the power of attorney or the sale deed. It is then submitted that charge sheet has already been submitted in this case and charge has already been framed on 09.04.2026. It is next submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 13.03.2026, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 12 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the submissions of the counsels and the fact as discussed above, I am inclined to enlarge the above-named petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Giridih, in connection with Giridih (T) P.S. Case No.420 of 2013 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case, with further condition that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
