Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with
Barkagaon P.S. Case No.01 of 2026 registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 111(2)(b), 111(3), 317(5) of the B.N.S. and Sections 25(1-A),
25(6), 25(7), 25(1-B)a, 26, 31, 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the co-accused and the petitioner were in
illegal possession of a pistol 7.65 mm made in U.S.A. written over it and
from four other co-accused persons fire arms were also recovered, while
from the petitioner one mobile phone was recovered. It is alleged that the
petitioner along with co-accused persons involved in commission of
organized crime. It is next submitted that the allegation against the
petitioner is false. It is further submitted that the co-accused person has
been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 08.04.2026 in B.A.
No.2483 of 2026. It again submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he
will co-operate with the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the
informant or witnesses of the case. It is lastly submitted that the
petitioner has been in custody since 08.01.2026 as mentioned in para-01 of
the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be
released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hazaribagh in connection with Barkagaon P.S. Case No.01 of 2026 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
