2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with
Kanke P.S. Case No.32 of 2026, for the alleged offences registered
under Sections 69 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 pending in the
Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ranchi.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that
the allegations are made that the petitioner has established the
relationship on the false pretext of marriage. She further submits
that in the FIR itself it has been disclosed that they were in
relationship six years prior to the lodging of FIR. She then submits
that both are major and what has happened that was consensual in
nature.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer
and submits that the allegations are there of establishing

relationship on the pretext of marriage. He further submits that the petitioner has intended to marry another lady. On these grounds, he submits that anticipatory bail may kindly be rejected.

5. Looking into the contents of the FIR, it transpires that the petitioner and informant were having relationship six years prior to lodging of FIR and FIR has been lodged on 04.02.2026 and from the contents of FIR it further transpires that they have met several times at different places and prima facie it appears what has happened that was consensual in nature. In the attending facts and circumstances of this case, I am inclined to provide anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner, above named, is hereby directed to surrender before the learned Court within three weeks from today, and in the event of his surrender/arrest, the petitioner, above named, shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ranchi in connection with Kanke P.S. Case No.32 of 2026, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
