1. Reference may be made to the order dated 18.07.2026 passed in the present contempt case, which reads as under:

"Mr. Binit Chandra, AC to AAG-III appearing on behalf of the opposite party no. 2, prays for and is allowed two weeks' more time to file show cause/compliance affidavit, failing which appropriate order against the said opposite party will be passed on the next date.

Put up this case under the heading "For Admission" after two weeks."

2. No show cause/compliance affidavit has been filed on behalf of the opposite party No. 2. Instead, an interlocutory application being I.A. No. 11121 of 2026 has been filed on behalf of the opposite party No. 2 seeking four weeks' further time to comply the order.
3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on consideration of the present interlocutory application, the opposite party No. 2 is granted further four weeks' time by way of last indulgence to file compliance affidavit, failing

which formal proceeding under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 will be initiated against the said opposite party.

4. I.A. No. 11121 of 2026 is accordingly disposed of.
