Earlier the prayer for bail of the appellant was rejected in I.A. No. 4297 of 2019.

The appellant is alleged to have caught hold of legs of his infant daughter and ripped her apart.

The postmortem report is supportive of the nature of allegations levelled against the appellant.

Although the learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant is in custody since 24.08.2014 but regard being had to the nature of allegation and the material available on record, we are not inclined to reconsider the prayer for bail of the appellant which stands rejected once again.

I.A. No. 7521 of 2022 stands rejected.
