Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Jarmundi
P.S. Case No.101 of 2025 registered for the offences punishable under
Sections 310(2), 331(4), 305(a) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the
allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner committed dacoity
and looted the ornaments, electronic article including LED T.V., cash and
other valuable. It is next submitted by learned senior counsel for the
petitioner that though the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. yet without
putting him under Test Identification Parade as mentioned in Para-08 of
the bail application, charge-sheet has been submitted against the
petitioner. It is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is
false. It is then submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-
operate with the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the
informant or witnesses of the case. It is lastly submitted that the
petitioner has been in custody since 17.11.2025 as mentioned in para-14 of
the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be
released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is
directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-

(Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned S.D.J.M., Dumka in connection with Jarmundi P.S. Case No.101 of 2025 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case.
