petitioner and learned A.P.P.

This application is directed against the judgment
dated 23.03.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions
Judge-III-cum-Children Court, Deoghar in connection with
Criminal (Juvenile Bail) Appeal No. 16/2026, whereby and
whereunder, the order dated 24.02.2026 passed by the learned
Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Deoghar in
connection with Pathrol P.S. Case No. 08/2026 rejecting the
prayer for bail of the petitioner has been affirmed.

It has been alleged that in course of checking, the
petitioner was apprehended by the Police and a country made
pistol along with a cartridge were recovered from his
possession.

Submission has been advanced by the learned
counsel for the petitioner that on completion of investigation,
charge sheet has been submitted. It has further been submitted
that the petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent and
he is in custody since 18.01.2026. Learned counsel further
submits that if the petitioner is granted bail, the father of the
petitioner shall ensure about the safe keep of the petitioner.

Learned A.P.P. has opposed the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

Regard being had to the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, while setting aside the judgment dated 23.03.2026 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-III-cum-Children Court, Deoghar in connection with Criminal (Juvenile Bail) Appeal No. 16/2026 and the order dated 24.02.2026 passed by the learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Deoghar in connection with Pathrol P.S. Case No. 08/2026 direct that the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) only with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Deoghar in connection with Pathrol P.S. Case No. 08/2026, subject to the condition that the father of the petitioner shall ensure the safe keep of the petitioner and shall also ensure that the petitioner is kept away from anti-social elements.

This application is allowed.
