06/ 08.05.2026: Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Dhanbad P.S. Case No. 417 of 2025, registered under sections 190, 191(2), 132, 121(1), 324 (3), 351(2), 352 of BNS, 2023, pending in the Court of learned C.J.M, Dhanbad.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on the basis of order passed in W.P.(C) No. 6771 of 2025 it is alleged that informant again measured the land however, the petitioners and others obstructed for the same. He next submits that the petitioners have nothing to do with the said allegation. He next submits that false allegation has been made against the petitioners and petitioners have got no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 16 of the petition. On these grounds, he submits that the petitioners may kindly be provided privilege of anticipatory bail.

4. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer and submits that petitioners are named in F.I.R.

5. Considering that in W.P.(C) No. 6771 of 2025 petitioner is Vishwanath Sharma and not this petitioner and it has been stated that

informant has again measured the land pursuant to that petitioners and others have obstructed the informant. In the order passed in the said writ petition there is only direction to the informant to make online entry. Further the petitioners have got no criminal antecedent which is disclosed in para 16 of the petition, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners. Accordingly, the above named, petitioners are directed to surrender before the learned court within three weeks from today and in the event of their surrender / arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 25,000/- (twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each, to the satisfaction of learned Dhanbad P.S. Case No. 417 of 2025, in connection with C.J.M, Dhanbad, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S, 2023.
