Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Nawadih P.S. case no. 71 of 2025 instituted under Section 310(2), 311, of BNS, 2023.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner committed dacoity and looted copper coil of 500KVA transformer. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and without putting him on TIP as mentioned in Para 10 of the bail application, charge-sheet has been submitted against him. It is further submitted that petitioner has been in custody since 18.12.2025, as mentioned in para 6 of the bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent, as mentioned in para 12 of the bail application. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready and willing to co-operate with the trial of the case and undertakes not to annoy or disturb the informant or the other witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case, hence, the petitioner may be admitted to regular bail.

Learned Addl. P.P. opposed the prayer for regular bail.

Considering submissions of learned counsels and the facts as stated above, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Hence, the court below is directed to release the petitioner on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Bermo at Tenughat in

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connection with Nawadih P.S. Case No. 71 of 2025 with the condition that the petitioner will co-operate with the trial of the case and will furnish mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change the mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the other witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
