Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with S.T. Case No. 521 of 2025 arising out of Gorhar P.S. Case No. 16 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 118(1), 109(1), 111(4), 3(5) of the B.N.S. and under Section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that in furtherance of common intention with the co-accused person, the petitioner attempted to commit murder of the husband of the informant by firing upon him. It is next submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is further submitted that the allegation of firing upon the husband of the informant is upon co-accused Hari Om Singh. It again submitted that the petitioner undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case. It is lastly submitted that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 09 and he has been in custody since 08.10.2025 as mentioned in para-10 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each

to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-VIII, Hazaribagh in connection with S.T. Case No. 521 of 2025 arising out of Gorhar P.S. Case No. 16 of 2025 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
