Heard the parties.

The petitioner has moved before this Court for grant of bail in connection with Complaint Case No. 510 of 2026 arising out of P.R. No. 14 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under sections 47(a), (b), (c), (d) of the Jharkhand Excise Act.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner was in illegal possession of 1318 bottles of illegal foreign liquor and two plastic jars filled with illegal foreign liquor, total 651 litre odd. It is further submitted that the allegations against the petitioner are all false and the petitioner has been in custody since 17.03.2026, as has been mentioned in paragraph no. 04 of the bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioner undertakes to cooperate with the trial of the case and further undertakes that he will not annoy or disturb the informant or the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. It is lastly submitted that the co-accused person with similar allegation has already been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated 30.04.2026 in **B.A. No. 3649 of 2026**. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioner be admitted to bail.

The learned Addl. P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/-

(Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of C.J.M. Chatra in connection with Complaint Case No. 510 of 2026 arising out of P.R. No. 14 of 2026 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
