This interlocutory application has been preferred by the petitioners for impleading the applicants mentioned in this interlocutory application as petitioners in the writ application.

It has been submitted that in the earlier round of litigation W.P.(C) No. 2413 of 2003 the persons who are being sought to be impleaded as petitioners were the petitioners in the said case. Since the issue in question concerns the parties who are being sought to be made as petitioners, this interlocutory application stands allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to add the petitioner nos. 1 to 13 in the present interlocutory application as the petitioner nos. 23 to 35 subject to deposit of the court fee.
