This application has been preferred by the petitioner for grant of exemption to surrender in terms of Rule 159 of the Jharkhand High Court Rules.

Submission has been advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is an old and ailing person and the fact that the petitioner is willing to settle the dispute with the opposite party no. 2. Learned counsel submits that the inclination of the petitioner to settle the dispute with the opposite party no. 2 can be borne out from the fact that an amount of Rs. 50,000/- has already been extended to the opposite party no. 2 in December, 2025.

Not a single chit of paper has been brought on record to suggest that the petitioner is indeed suffering from some health issues. So far as the deposit of Rs. 50,000/- is concerned, the same is a meagre amount compared to the compensation amount which has been awarded in favor of the opposite party no. 2 to the tune of Rs. 10 lakhs.

The aforesaid does not implore this Court to grant exemption to the petitioner to surrender and consequent thereof, this application stands rejected.

I.A. No. 6383 of 2025 stands rejected.
