Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Tisri
P.S. Case No. 18 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1027 of 2022
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 25(1-B)(a), 26, 35
of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegation
against the petitioner is that the petitioner was involved in illegal
possession of a country-made pistol and one live cartridge which was
recovered from the co-accused Randhir Kumar Choudhary. It is next
submitted that the allegation against the petitioner is false. It is then
submitted that no recovery has been made from the petitioner. It is
also submitted that charge sheet has been submitted in this case. It is
further submitted that the petitioner is an old person of 60 years. It is
next submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.11.2025
as is evident from para-14 of the instant bail application. It is lastly
submitted that the petitioner undertakes to co-operate with the trial of
the case and also undertakes not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of
the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is
submitted that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for
bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate-1st Class, Giridih in connection with Tisri P.S. Case No. 18 of 2022 corresponding to G.R. Case No. 1027 of 2022 **with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and he will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
