1. The case has been listed under the heading for orders for hearing on the issue of maintainability, as would be evident from office note dated 04.05.2026.
2. Heard learned counsel for the appellant.
3. Let notice be issued upon the respondent, both by speed post with A/D and ordinary process, for which, requisites etc. must be filed within a week.
4. Learned counsel for the appellant has submitted that since proceeding is still pending before the Original Court i.e., learned Family Court, Hazaribagh in Original Suit No. 68 of 2025, as such permission has been sought for to serve notice through the counsel, who is representing the respondent in the learned Family Court, Hazaribagh.
5. Considering the nature of lis, this Court thought it proper to grant such leave.

6. Accordingly, in addition to the mode of notice, as mentioned above, let notice be issued upon the respondent through the counsel who is representing the respondent in the Original Suit No. 68 of 2025.

7. The court concerned, i.e., the Learned Family court, Hazaribagh will ensure service of notice upon the respondent herein, and submit a report to that effect before this Court on or before the next of hearing.

8. Notice is made returnable on 16.06.2026.

9. The issue of maintainability is left open to be adjudicated after appearance of the respondent.
