Heard the parties.

The petitioner has been made accused in connection with Argora
P.S. Case No. 06 of 2025 registered for the offence punishable under
Sections 309(6) of the B.N.S.

This is the second journey of the petitioner with the prayer
for regular bail, as earlier the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner was
rejected on merits vide order dated 23.09.2025 in B.A. No.8184 of 2025.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the fresh ground is
that in the meanwhile three witnesses have been examined in this case
during trial, out of whom, the P.W.1 has not attributed any specific role
to the petitioner for the alleged occurrence though he has stated about
three persons committing robbery. It is next submitted that the allegation
against the petitioner is false. It is further submitted that P.W.2 and P.W.
3 have not stated anything to implicate the petitioner in this case. The co-
accused person has been admitted to bail by this Court vide order dated
27.02.2026 in B.A. No.1719 of 2026. It also submitted that the petitioner
undertakes that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and will not
annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case. It is lastly
submitted that the petitioner has been in custody since 01.02.2025 as
mentioned in para-01 of the instant bail application. Hence it is submitted
that the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned Addl.P.P. opposes the prayer for bail.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M.-XIII, Ranchi in connection with Argora P.S. Case No. 06 of 2025 with the condition that he will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish his mobile number and photocopy of the Aadhar Card in the court below with an undertaking that he will not change his mobile number during the trial of the case and will not annoy or disturb the informant or witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.
