Heard the parties.

The petitioners have been made accused in connection with Kolebira P.S. Case No. 09 of 2026 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 18, 27(a), 28, 29 30 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the allegation against the petitioners was that the petitioners were involved in cultivation of poppy plants. It is next submitted that the allegations against the petitioners are all false. It is then submitted that the petitioners have no concern with the place of occurrence land. It is

further submitted that the petitioners have been in custody since 21.02.2026 as is evident from para-18 of the instant bail application. It is next submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-18 of the bail application. It is lastly submitted that the petitioners undertake to co-operate with the trial of the case and also undertake not to annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case. Hence, it is submitted that the petitioners be released on bail.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioners.

Considering the facts of this case, the above-named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, N.D.P.S. Act, Simdega in connection with Kalebira P.S. Case No. 09 of 2026 **with the condition that they will co-operate with the trial of the case and furnish their mobile numbers and photocopy of the Aadhar Cards in the court below with an undertaking that they will not change their mobile number during the trial of the case and they will not annoy or disturb the witnesses of the case in any manner during the trial of the case.**
