2. I.A. No.13651 of 2025 has been filed for modification of the order dated 01.07.2025.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the claimants submits that the appellant Assurance Company was directed to deposit entire awarded amount along with interest before the District Certificate Officer, Bokaro within three weeks and it was observed that out of the deposited amount, sum of Rs.1,00,000/- shall be released in favour of the claimants on proper verification and rest of the amount shall be kept intact, which will be subject to result of the present appeal.

4. He submits, pursuant to that, the Assurance Company has deposited the cheque in compliance of the said order before the District Certificate Officer, Bokaro. He submits that however the District Certificate Officer, Bokaro is not having any bank account, in view of that, that has not been deposited and it is lying in the said office. In this background, he submits that the order for deposition may be modified to the effect that the said amount will be deposited before the learned District Judge-I cum Presiding Officer, Motor

Accident Claim Tribunal, Bokaro in connection with M.A.C.C. No.132 of 2019.

5. Mr. Manish learned counsel appearing for the Assurance Company submits that the Assurance Company has already deposited the cheque. He further submits that if such a situation is there, the Court can modify the said order.

6. In view of the above and considering that the District Certificate Officer, Bokaro is not having any Bank account and in that view of the matter, the Assurance Company is put at liberty to take the said cheque from the office of District Certificate Officer, Bokaro and the direction dated 01.07.2025 passed in M.A. No.160 of 2024 shall be complied by the Assurance Company by depositing the said amount before the learned District Judge-I cum Presiding Officer, Motor Accident Claim Tribunal, Bokaro in connection with M.A.C.C. Case No.132 of 2019 and on proper verification, a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- shall be released in favour of the claimants and the rest amount shall be kept intact in terms of order dated 01.07.2025, which will be subject to the result of M.A. No.160 of 2024.

7. The Order dated 01.07.2025 passed in M.A. No.160 of 2024 is modified to above extent.

8. As such, the I.A. No. 13651 of 2025 is allowed and disposed of.

9. Let this matter appear before appropriate Bench.
